The Characteristics of the Course

Small classes arranged to the levels of the learners to enhance the effect of learning.
Language instruction performed by teachers with profound knowledge and experience.
Detailed advice and guidance regarding aspects of daily life.
A campus located in the suburb of an international tourist town with hot springs.
An effective and peaceful educational environment.
Inexpensive living expenses compared to some of the bigger cities in Japan.
Accommodation facilities available for international students.

The Term of Study

One year. However, students who want to improve their ability of Japanese can extend the term by 6 to 12 months.
The students enter in April or October.
The term of studying for the students entering;
① in April is from April to the next February,
② in October is from October to the following September.
The number of classes in a week is 30 hours, and about 780 hours a year.
The school hours are from 9 to 15:10; from Monday to Friday.

The Limit of the Number of the Students

The combined total number of students who may enter in October 2026 and April 2027 is 80.

The Application Requirements

1. Those who have completed ordinary 12-year-education in foreign countries, or those who are due to complete such and fulfill the application requirements for university in those countries.
2. Those who fulfill the university application requirements of educational systems in foreign countries.
3. Those who have Japanese ability equivalent to Japanese-Language Proficiency Test N5.

The applicants post the application items during the application period, or the applicants or their agents bring the items directly to Beppu University.

Examination Fee: 10,000 yen

When the applicants transfer the fee into Beppu University's bank account, they must deposit 12,000 yen including commission. Once the fee is deposited, it cannot be refunded.

How to Select from the Applicants

Following receipt of application documents a written examination and interview will take place. These will be examined and judged by the selection committee.

Notification of Selection

Beppu University informs applicants or their agent of the result by sending a "Notification of Acceptance" by email.

The Entrance Procedures

As soon as you get the photocopy of the certificate of eligibility, you must pay both the entrance fee and the tuition fee. To the students who have completed the payment of entrance fee and tuition fee, the certificate of the permission of entrance and the certificate of eligibility will be sent.

The Deadline of Entrance Procedures

The students who will enter in October, 2026: August 15, 2026
The students who will enter in April, 2027: February 15, 2027

The Entrance Fee and the Tuition Fee

The entrance fee: 150,000 yen
The tuition fee: 500,000 yen

1. Pay the fees into Beppu University's bank account or bring the fees directly to the finance accounting office of the University.
2. When you transfer the money from overseas, be sure to transfer from the bank account. Transfer the total sum of 652,000 yen including of commission.
3. When you transfer the money in Japan, transfer from the bank or send it by registered mail. You must not use the post office transfer system.
4. It is possible for the agents to bring the fees directly to the finance office.
5. Once the entrance fee is paid, they cannot be refunded for any reasons. However, on condition that the students cannot obtain visas, the fees will be refunded.

The Permit of Entrance

Those who have completed the entrance procedures will be sent the permit of entrance and the relevant documents. As soon as you receive the documents, you may go through the procedures necessary to leave your country such as visa.

If a student cannot enter Japan by the term of validity written in the permit of entrance, it is likely that the permit of entrance will be revoked.

Other expenses

1. National Health Insurance: about 20,000 yen a year
2. Housing insurance in the case of living in private apartments: about 4,000 yen a year
3. Textbooks: about 15,000 yen (half-year)
4. ¥3,000 yearly for miscellaneous expenses
5. Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) exam fee = 15,000 yen [7,500 yen x 2 times (July and December)]

The Documents for Application

1	Application Form (form designated by Beppu University)
2	A clear photocopy of the graduation certificate or the certificate of expectation of graduation or the certificate of graduation.
3	The transcript for each academic year in Last Education (high school) .
4	6 photos (4cm × 3cm) (write on the back your name, nationality, and birthdate)
5	A photocopy of passport (the page with photograph and the pages which have the record of your entry to Japan)
6	Financial Supporter Document (accompanied by a Japanese translation of it) (form designated by Beppu University) (to be filled in by the financial guarantor) (Japanese translation)
7	Financial supporter's bank balance certificate (accompanied by its Japanese translation) and the certificate of income of the supporter (Japanese translation) , the latter of which can be substituted for the certificate of income tax (Japanese translation) .
8	The family registry (all the members of the family should be recorded)
9	Employment certificate of financial supporter (accompanied by its Japanese translation) or attested copy of the person responsible for the enterprise
10	Employment certificate of the student if employed. (accompanied by its Japanese translation)
11	The letter of recommendation issued by the educational institute. (for those in an educational institution) (form designated by Beppu University) (Japanese translation)
12	The certificate of the result of Japanese-Language Proficiency Test or J Test.

If the guarantor of the student lives in Japan, the student needs to hand in further documents.

Notes on the certificate of the bank balance

1. The certificate must be original. The photo copy is not permitted.
2. The certificate of the bank balance
For the students who enter in October 2026 : the certificate after March 1, 2026 is valid.
For the students who enter in April 2027 : the certificate after August 1, 2026 is valid.
3. The certificate of foreign currency deposit must be without time limit.
4. The holder of the bank account, the depositor, and the name on the certificate of balance must all be the same person.

Medical Expenses and Support

The students who stay in Japan more than a year must join National Health Insurance. Oita prefecture subsidizes a part of the insurance cost.

The Discount for the Students

By presenting students ID cards, the students can obtain discounted rail passes and student vouchers.

Privilege for the students who will study in Beppu University

Entrance fee exemption.

Offer the recommendation for the entrance examinations to the students whose attendance is more than 90 percent of all the classes.

Living Expenses in Beppu

1. Rent of private apartment: 25,000 yen to 35,000 yen a month

Note: When you start to live in the apartment, you need to pay three to five- month security deposit.

2. Food expenses: about 30,000 yen

3. Other expenses: about 20,000 yen

Accommodation

(1) Beppu University International Student Dormitory

As a general rule, new students live in Beppu University International Student Dormitory, a dormitory for international students, for half a year.

Housing costs, facilities, equipment, etc. are as follows.

① 52 rooms in total (49 single rooms, 3 family rooms). Each room is equipped with a desk, chair, air conditioner, bath, and toilet.

② The cooking room, dining room, and washing machine are shared. Water, electricity, and gas fees are paid by meter.

③ Residence costs for a single room are 23,000 yen room fee (monthly), 3,000 yen common service fee (monthly) and 10,000 yen maintenance fee.

When you move into the dormitory, you will pay the cost (140,000 yen) for half a year (5 months) in one lump sum.

(2) Private apartment

Six months after enrollment, students will live in a private apartment. The average monthly room charge starts from 25,000 yen.

Approximately 35,000 yen. *Average monthly living expenses are around 75,000 yen to 85,000 yen.

Outdoor Activities

One-day trips both in May and November

Sister Schools

Beppu University has many sister schools in China, Korea, Taiwan, etc., and facilitate international exchange.

Overall Outline of Procedures from Commencement until Admission

The students handing in the application sheets → Examination of documents, written examination and interview → The university sending notification to the students who passed the examination → The university applying to the Immigration Office for the certificate of legibility → The university obtaining the certificate of eligibility → The university sending to the students the documents including the photo copy of the certificate of eligibility, the request paper of entrance fee and tuition fee, and questionnaire about flight and accommodation → The students paying for entrance fee and tuition fee → The students sending to the university the questionnaire about flight and accommodation → The university sending to the students the certificate of eligibility and the certificate of entrance → The students applying for the student visa to Japan's Embassy → The university picking up the students in Fukuoka Airport → The student's admission.
